Notice of Tentative Determination, Informational Meeting and Public Hearing

In accordance with Sections 1-601, 1-602, 1-604, and 9-209 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of the Environment (the "Department") has made a Tentative Determination to approve a Refuse Disposal Permit Application submitted by Tolson & Associates, LLC for the construction and operation of the proposed Tolson & Associates Rubble Landfill. This landfill, a nonhazardous solid waste acceptance facility, is to be located at the end of Capitol Raceway Road, Crofton, in Anne Arundel County, Maryland.

To provide an opportunity for interested citizens to obtain information about the proposed landfill and the Department's Tentative Determination, an Informational Meeting and a Public Hearing are scheduled for August 18, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the Crofton Elementary School Cafeteria/Auditorium located at 1405 Duke of Kent Drive, Crofton, MD 21114. That evening immediately following the Informational Meeting, a Public Hearing will be held to provide the citizens an opportunity to formally comment on the Department's Tentative Determination concerning the proposed landfill. A Public Informational Meeting concerning this application was previously held on July 15, 2004 in the Crofton Elementary School Cafeteria.

Upon request, the Department will provide an interpreter for the deaf or hearing-impaired persons. The permit application, supporting documents, and draft permit will be available for review at the Anne Arundel Public Library located at 1270 Odenton Road, Odenton, Anne Arundel County, MD 21113 and at the Department by appointment after August 2, 2011.

A 30-day written comment period regarding the application will be in effect until the close of business on September 9, 2011. Address all comments to Mr. Horacio Tablada, Director, Land Management Administration, 1800 Washington Boulevard, Baltimore, MD 21230-1719.
